Gould Street Reconstruction – Notice to Residents Contract No. 25-08

Construction Details

Work will occur on Gould Street from Elm Street to Division Street, Pengally Avenue from Gould Street to McNaughton Street, and McNaughton Street from Pengally Avenue to Mary Street starting late May 2025 to December 2025. The main intersections along Gould Street (Mary, Frank, George, and William Streets) will remain open until work commences in the intersection. Separate notifications will be delivered to update local residents before these intersections are planned to be closed. The work involves the removal of existing infrastructure and the installation of sanitary sewers, storm sewers, watermain, urbanization including curb and gutter and sidewalk with tactile plates, boulevard restoration and complete road reconstruction. You will be notified if there will be direct impacts to your property or entrance.

Work Hours

Generally, work will take place between 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday to Friday and on Saturdays if necessary. No work is expected on Sundays or outside of daylight hours. Work will not take place during statutory or other major holidays unless an emergency occurs. Advance notice of any weekend or holiday work will be provided whenever possible.

Preliminary Site Work

Prior to construction, utility companies will locate their existing infrastructure. Pre-condition surveys will be carried out on buildings in the vicinity of the proposed work. A separate notice will be issued to residents to coordinate the surveys.

Disruptions

As with all construction projects, there will be some temporary inconveniences to the local community. The Contractor will notify affected residents of any anticipated disruption including road closures and other access restrictions. During work hours, residents and businesses will experience some noise due to excavation and construction equipment. During construction you can expect water service shutdowns; however, the Contractor will notify you in advance unless an emergency watermain shutdown is required. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated as we aim to complete the project safely and efficiently.

Pedestrian and Vehicle Access

- Vehicle traffic disruptions will be throughout the entire construction project as the road will be closed except to local traffic only. Signs will be posted to advise of any road closures.
- Access to driveways may be restricted at times to allow for construction. Residents will be advised by on-site personnel ahead of any restrictions.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained. We encourage residents with mobility limitations to contact the project team so their specific needs can be addressed.
- Emergency (police, fire and medical response) access will be maintained at all times.
- The Contractor may be required to transport recycling and garbage containers to either end of the work site where they can be picked up by the Town's collection contractor. We ask that you clearly label your containers with your address so they can be returned to you.

Weekly Email updates

Weekly emails will be sent out relating to the project to help inform residents of that week's construction schedule. This will consist of projected construction area, a general description of what items the contractor will be constructing and what impacts the residents should expect.
